

VEHICLE PURCHASES FOR MINORS (Non-hearing matters)

In order for a vehicle purchase for minor to be addressed as a non hearing matter the following guidelines must be met. If the 5 first requirements are not met in the petition, the matter will be placed on pending status for receipt of same.

The petition for purchase of vehicle must state the following:

- 1. The minors age/DOB**
- 2. Reason for the purchase, (i.e. transportation for work, family need , etc.)**
- 3. Proof of minor having a valid Alabama Driver License**
- 4. Proof of minor maintaining a B average in school**
- 5. Proof of having (or currently taking) drivers education.**

If the above requirements are met, the petition will be established as a non-hearing matter, GAL appointed, etc. And once the report of GAL is filed the matter will be addressed as normal procedure.

If petition is granted, subsequent proof of the following are required by the Court and a due date certain on a Friday dispo to be put in order.

- 1. Proof of Insurance, collision and liability.**
- 2. Title to vehicle taken in the name of the conservator.**
- 3. Cost of vehicle should not exceed \$12,000.00 (a lesser amount may be imposed for modest estates)**

If the above requirements cannot be addressed or met, the petition will be set for court.
